Members, you're invited to submit an article to the St. Louis Publishers Association newsletter and blog! Please read the following guidelines *before* you get started.

Eligibility and Permissions

- Author must be an SLPA member in good standing
- Author grants SLPA permission to print an excerpt in the newsletter, post the article in its entirety to the blog, and store it in an electronic archive.
- Author retains all copyrights

Submission Details

- Article length cap: 1,000 words for blog posts, 500 words for newsletter articles
- Article should address some aspect of the writing/publishing industry (may include your personal publishing experience)
- Article must be typed in a Word document, sent via email
- <u>Article must include</u> subject title, your name, web address/primary social media contact, and title of book (if applicable) as you want it to appear in the byline

Accepted articles will appear in brief in the monthly newsletter and in full on the SLPA blog. Only submissions that meet these criteria will be considered. All articles are subject to light editing for content and length. The SLPA publishes articles at its discretion.
